



Cummins Megasite reinforces its commitment to the communities Completes one year of successful operations

Phaltan, January 16: Cummins, the leading manufacturer of engines, generators and related technologies, on the occasion of completing one year of successful operations at the Megasite in Phaltan on January 14, 2012 reinforced once again its commitment to the local communities. Through a series of Corporate Responsibility initiatives, over 330 employees from the Cummins Megasite volunteered more than 1000 hours of their time to improve the lives of those living in Phaltan and neighbouring towns.

These volunteers planted more than 750 saplings and few others screened awareness videos on sanitation and environment protection towards educating over 1000 students from S.S.English school and Mudhoji High school in Phaltan and three other schools across Nandal, Sakharwadi and Taradgaon.

The first three plants that were launched at the Megasite a year ago were the second manufacturing facility of Tata Cummins Limited producing engines for commercial vehicles, power generation and industrial markets, an engine rebuild center and a reconditioning facility for remanufacturing engines and components. This was followed by the inauguration of the fourth plant Parts Distribution Center (PDC) and the ground breaking for the plant that will manufacture B, C, and L series engines, in August 2011.

Nagarajan Balanaga, Vice President – Human Resource, Cummins Group in India, said at the Megasite Foundation Day, “We are delighted with the sustainable Corporate Responsibility partnerships we have built with the communities in and around Phaltan. We are on the verge of completion of the upgradation of the ITI Phaltan. We have also donated over 800 cooking stoves (chulhas) to the village households thus providing a sustainable solution towards a greener and cleaner environment. Our key initiatives on soil and water conservation and entrepreneurship development upon completion will deliver progressive benefits to the communities. We are humbled to play our part in making a positive difference in the lives of the residents of Phaltan and neighbouring villages.”

Besides Phaltan, Cummins has taken up significant number of sustainable initiatives in the adjoining villages - Nandal, Surwadi and Dhawlewadi.
